FLOOR MAT

You can make this mat as large or as small as necessary, depending on whether you want to put it in the kitchen, bathroom, or entryway. I've used two layers of fabric to make it thick and sturdy.



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

28 $\frac{3}{4}$ " \times 19 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

MATERIALS

Thick cotton: 59" \times 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cotton tape ($\frac{3}{4}$ " wide): 41"

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Cut the cotton tape into two equal lengths of approximately 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " each. With the top of the mat right side up, place the tape on the mat as shown in the diagram. Edgestitch along the long sides of the tape.
- 2 Place the mat top on the mat bottom, right sides together. Align the edges and sew $\frac{3}{8}$ " from the edge along all four sides, leaving an opening of about 6" on one of the long sides.
- 3 Turn the mat right side out. Fold the open edge $\frac{3}{8}$ " to the wrong side, press, and hand stitch the opening closed.

CUTTING THE FABRIC

Dimensions include the seam allowance. All seam allowances are $\frac{3}{8}$ ".
